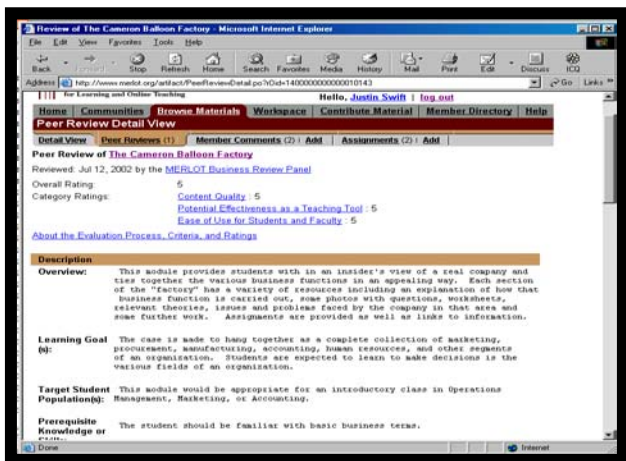

To become a Peer Reviewer you must:

- be an instructor at an institute of higher learning,
- have demonstrated expertise in the discipline,
- be recognized for excellence in teaching,
- have had experience using technology in teaching, and
- be an active member of your discipline association(s).
